OUTREACH, MISSIONS, AND EVANGELISM

1. The Persecuted Church – Algeria

This week, authorities in Algeria ordered the closure of two of the largest Christian churches in the nation, affecting a total of at least 1500 believers. This happened due to a law that mandates any non-Muslim worship be conducted in specific, designated buildings. With these closures, seven of Algeria's Protestant churches have been closed in the past six weeks.

2. Missions – Syria

Intercede for three Alliance churches in northern Syria that are located in the "hot zone" of the Turkish invasion. Continue to pray for wisdom for the pastors and the Syrian Alliance president, as they determine if their congregations should stay or flee to safety. Also, pray for other Aran and Kurdish Christians in northern Syria who face voluntary or forced displacement in the face of the aggression and foreign occupation.

GENERAL REQUESTS

1. We pray for our **nation**, our **President**, our **troops** abroad and at home, and **their families**, and those who have returned with **trauma**. We pray also for wisdom and safety of our **law enforcement officers and first responders**.
2. We pray for **Israel** and peace for **Jerusalem**
