OUTREACH, MISSIONS, AND EVANGELISM

1. The Persecuted Church - India

Five Christians in India were beaten mercilessly after they refused to recant their Christian faith. These recent converts to Christianity were taken from their homes by a mob of angry Hindu villagers and told they must "return" to Hinduism and recant their Christian faith. The five Christians refused to deny their new found faith and were severely beaten by members of the mob wielding bamboo rods.

2. Missions - Chile
