I Thessalonians 5:1-11



Main Point:

**We're called to continue to encourage
and build one another up in the
Lord.**

Encourage – called to one's side for
exhortation, comfort, help.



Build(edify) – to help one to grow,
be established, uplifted, founded
in the faith.



1. We encourage each other... that we are not appointed to suffer wrath at the coming of the Lord Jesus Christ but to receive salvation! Verse 10

**‘Day of the Lord’ or ‘the Day’ = the
Day of Christ’s return and
retribution.**

exclusion – being shut out from
the Lord's presence.**

II Thessalonians 1:6-10


2. We encourage each other that we belong to the light, and are to put on the armor daily: Faith, hope, love.

**3. We encourage each other that
whether we are alive or asleep
(die) we live together with the
Lord Jesus Christ! Verse 10**
