GENERAL REQUESTS

OUTREACH, MISSIONS, AND EVANGELISM

1. The Persecuted Church – Ethiopia

Though a primarily Christian nation, there are still struggles with persecution, especially in southern Ethiopia, where the Gospel has not yet fully permeated the communities. There, churches have been destroyed and Christians harassed, killed, or maimed. Muslims are the leading perpetrators, especially in areas where they are the majority and see Christianity as a false religion.

2. Missions – Philippines

Continue praying for victims of an earthquake last month. The earthquake's epicenter is located where the Alliance constituency resides. There are 170 churches in the area- 36 were completely destroyed, 68 had partial damages, and 1,800 homes of Alliance members were damaged. Also, the Mount Apo Alliance Bible College sustained considerable damage to chapel and dorms.
