## OUTREACH, MISSIONS, AND EVANGELISM

### 1. The Persecuted Church – World Wide

According to a 2018 report, 70 countries around the world have blasphemy, heresy, and apostasy laws, which punish beliefs opposing the country's religious teaching and conversion to a new religion. The laws prohibit statements about the divinity of Jesus or attempts to spread the Gospel. Pakistan has some of the most severe laws, clearly slanted to protect Islam.

### 2. Missions – Hong Kong

Continue to pray for Hong Kong, where tensions have escalated recently after nearly six months of protests, crippling public transportation, closing highways, and suspending university classes. Elections will take place November 24 for members of the legislature. Pray for the protection of God's people and His work there and that the truth of the gospel will penetrate angry, broken hearts.

### GENERAL REQUESTS

1. We pray for our **nation**, our **President**, our **troops** abroad and at home, and **their families**, and those who have returned with **trauma**. We pray also for wisdom and safety of our **law enforcement officers and first responders**.
