Message: Serve One Another // Scripture: Mark 10:43-45, Romans 12:6-8, Ephesians 4:11-13 // Series: One Another

CHECK IN ON ONE ANOTHER

Share about your week and pray for one another's personal prayer needs.

First, let's recap Sunday's message and read our passages of Scripture together.

Q1: What were the main things from the sermon that you remember from Sunday? Why do those stand out to you?

Q2: When you hear the phrase "serve one another," what do you think that means? Especially, what do you think that means as Christians?

TRANSFORMATION THROUGH SERVICE

God cannot transform our lives if all we always come at Jesus' church and the people we are called to love and belong to in self-serving and self-seeking ways. We cannot spend our time in church with the question: "What's in it for me?"

If we want to understand how to serve one another to our best ability, we look toward the example of Jesus.

Q3: What makes Jesus an example of a servant? Where are times in Scripture that you remember Jesus serving? What is ironic about Jesus being a servant?

If you have no interest in serving one another and serving alongside one another in Jesus' church, then you will never discover and live into your Christ-given purpose and Christ-given mission.

Q4: What are some of the common barriers toward serving one another that we see today? How can we be a part of removing barriers in our own lives and maybe in the lives of others too?

Pastor Daniel shared three outcomes from serving one another.

Q5: How does serving one another bond us more deeply with Christ and others?

Q6: How does serving one another equip us with the gifts of Christ?

Q7: How does serving one another build us up to become more like Christ?

Q8: As a Christian, serving others belongs in several places, not just the church. What are some of the places in your life, both in church and out of church, where you think you may need to be serving?

Jesus has given us everything that we need to be faithful right now. Let's be faithful to serve one another in the capacities that we are able today

CALL TO ACTION:

- 1) Pray for your non-Christian friends to come to faith in Jesus.
- 2) Pray for your unchurched/de-churched friends to join a local church.
- 3) Pray for God to show you ways that you can serve one another.
