## **Blessing and Praise**

**Psalm 67**

Let all the peoples praise God!

Blessed by God (1-2)

Praise to God (3-5)

Harvest of God (6-7)

ICE BREAKER: What dish could you best teach a cooking class on how to make?

### **DISCUSSION**

Notice how the request for grace and blessing in verse 1 is *so that* the Gospel is proclaimed among the nations (v2). What other purposes do we often ask God for grace and/or blessing?

Trace the flow of grace in this Psalm: Bless me -> Save them -> Praise God  
How is God's grace at work in each movement?

There is confident certainty in the blessing and harvest of God in verses 6-7. How does this certainty inform and inspire our unafraid witness?

**PRAY:** Read 1 Timothy 2:1-6. Pray for God's agenda to advance amongst specific governments and nations, that believers would praise God.

**ASSESS**

When people observe your life, do they see evidence of the transforming power of the gospel—joy, repentance, humility, love, and dependence on Christ?

Do you view the people around you as part of God's mission field, or do you primarily think of missions as something that happens somewhere else?

**APPLY**

What specific blessing from God can you leverage this week—your time, resources, relationships, skills, or experiences—for the sake of someone else knowing Christ?

What is one practical way you can intentionally display and declare the gospel to someone in your everyday sphere this week?

**PRAY:**

Pray for an opportunity this week to make known the saving power of Jesus with someone specific.

Pray about your next step in participating in God's mission through our church i.e. praying, giving, serving, discipling, or sending.
