Pergamum	The Church of the Age of Constantine	AD 313 - 600
Thyatira	The Church of the Dark Ages	A.D. 600-1517
Sardis	The Reformation Church	A.D. 1517-1648
Philadelphia	The Missionary Church	A.D. 1648-1900
Laodicea	The Church of the Apostasy	A.D. 1900-present
