## Exploring the Word – Romans 8:1-4

- 1. As you listened to the message, what points stood out?
- 2. Read Romans 8:1. In this chapter of Scripture, the apostle Paul begins to focus on the work of the Holy Spirit. Thus far in Romans, he has only written about the Holy Spirit four times (refer to Romans 1:4, 2:29, 5:5, and 7:6). Read these verses and discuss the significance of the Holy Spirit in each verse.
- 3. Why is there no condemnation for those who have put their faith in Christ?
- 4. Read Romans 8:2. What activities of the Holy Spirit are mentioned in this verse?
- 5. Read Romans 8:3-4. The Holy Spirit is the third person in the Trinity of God. Discuss the nature of the fellowship between the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. How does the Holy Spirit complement the Father and the Son?
- 6. How do we know if we are living by the power of the Spirit? What types of things will we pursue and what "kind of fruit" will be evident in our lives (refer to Galatians 5:22-23)?
