June 12: A New Community

"What happened at Pentecost was that God's people became a Spirit-filled body of Christ." – John Stott

When the Christian Church was born 50 days after the First Easter, a new community of Christians was formed. Acts 2:42–47 gives us a "family portrait" of that first church. What we see is a community devoted to spiritual growth, authentic relationships, vibrant worship, and a living witness. When those take place in God's church today, we see a deeper connection to God, stronger relationships with one another, and all people experiencing transformation and belonging.
