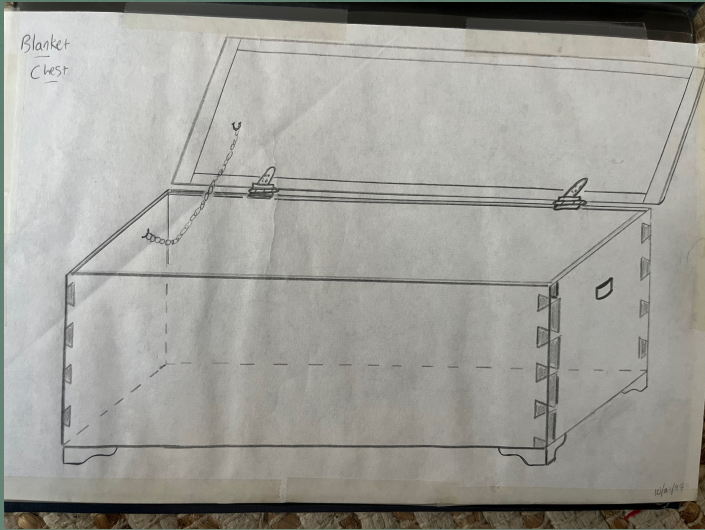


## 3:1-5 “...*that it may be well for you*”

- **Principle: Life with Christ is the fullest, most abundant life possible!**
- Boaz (a foreshadow of Christ)
- Protects, Provides, Cares, Has a future for!
- Naomi helps Ruth make her request clear:
- *In no uncertain terms, I want long-term relationship with you!*













## 3:6-9 “...*for you are a redeemer!*”

- Principle: Ruth **ASKS** to begin a long-term relationship!
- She doesn't just “assume it” or “ooze” into it.
- She is Deliberate! (Versus “Hanging around”)
- She takes action with urgent intention.
- Is this how you have pursued Christ?





## 3:6-9 “...*for you are a redeemer!*”

- **Matt. 11:12**: Effort, Urgent intention, Stop-at-nothing force
- **Mark 5:27**: She takes hold bc she's desperate!
- **Luke 5:19** The friends rip up a stranger's roof!
- **Luke 18:35-43** The blind man INSISTS on crying out to

Jesus!









## 3:10-12a “...it is true that I am a redeemer”

- Principle: “*Whosoever comes to the Lord He will in no wise cast away!*” John 6:37
- Boaz, as a picture of Christ, assures Ruth:
- “*Do not fear*”: even in hardship or storms
- “*I will do for all that you ask*”: I can be trusted
- “*I am a redeemer*”: You were bought at a price!





- **Admit**: Without a Savior, I'm lost/disconnected/dead!  
I know I need You.
- **Believe**: Jesus, You are who you say you are. Your life and death pays MY debt completely!
- **Commit**: I give you my whole life. My thoughts, words and actions; my hopes, dreams and plans; my family, money, and career; my mistakes and sins past, present and future.
