# Romans, chs. 1-8

- The Gospel
  - \*Man's starting point before God
  - \*How we try to fix our unrighteousness
  - \*The ONLY sufficient Justification
  - \*The Believer's new Identity!



• Vv 18-22 "all of creation groans..."

(1) We live in a system that bears the curse of sin

- a) Eve's sin and consequence: Childbirth pain
- b) Adam's sin and consequence: Cursed ground

Gen. 3:16-17



• Vv 18-22 "all of creation groans..."

(2) BUT Believer's are poised to look FORWARD!

- a) "...the glory TO BE revealed in us..." (18)
- b) "...creation waits ... for the revealing..." (19)
- c) "...creation itself WILL BE set free..." (21)
- d) "...creation groans...until now..." (22)



• Vv 23-27 "we await our adoption as sons..."

- (1) The Now (suffering) and the Not Yet (glory)
  - a) We are "officially" adopted (8:15-17)
    - -But there will be depth and intimacy to come
  - b) Our bodily Redemption is also promised (23)
    - for which we "wait eagerly" (25)



• Vv 23-27 "the Spirit intercedes for us with groans..."

(2) The Spirit pleads for us in our weakness

- a) When we struggle, when we doubt
- b) B/c we don't know what's best for us
- c) B/c we don't know the future



- Vv 28-34 "Those whom He foreknew He predestined..."
  - (1) The GOSPEL: God did everything. We did Nothing.
    - a) Foreknew (in our Condition!)
    - b) Predestined (in spite of our Unrighteousness)
    - c) Called (out of our rebellion, enmity, hostility)
    - d) Justified (Christ trades His perfection for my sin)
    - e) Glorified (the "Not Yet" for which we hope)



- Vv 28-34 "If God is for us, who can be against us?"
  - (2) What can Believer's trust?
    - a) We are being conformed to Christ-likeness
    - b) God is FOR us
    - c) The evidence God is "all-in" is Jesus!
    - d) Christ's righteousness protects/identifies us Isaiah 50:8-9



- Vv 35-39 "Who will separate us from the Love of God?"
  - (1) The LOVE of GOD is our foundation
    - a) nothing can separate us from it
    - b) It is the reason for victory in suffering/death
    - c) It is not "ethereal" it can be SEEN in Christ's life and death!

Deut. 7:6-8
