Hey everybody. Welcome back to the Christmas Box journey of looking for the Messiah. Today is day 13, and today we learn that he will be the Messiah. I know that sounds a little weird at this point because we've been referring to him as the Messiah throughout this entire journey, but today we're going to look a little bit more about what the word Messiah actually means. The word Messiah comes from the Hebrew word mishak, which just means anointed one. See, the kings of Israel, they were anointed with oil. The oil was poured on their head to set them apart as king. And so this word that means anointed is where we get the word Messiah and it's actually translated Christ in Greek, and that's where we get Jesus the Christ that is Jesus the Messiah. And so today we look at Psalm two and Psalm two is one of the earliest passages in the Old Testament where the word Messiah or anointed one refers to the promised seed from Genesis three 15, the one we've been looking for all along. And so in Psalm two, the Messiah, the seed of the woman, he's the son of God. He's the great king that the Lord has established on his holy mountain who will destroy his enemies. In the day of his wrath today, we learned that he will be the Messiah. Join us tomorrow as we continue to look for the Messiah.
