Read Acts 11:27-30; Romans 15:26-27; 1 Corinthians 16; and 2 Corinthians 8-9. Paul is taking up a collection for the saints suffering in Jerusalem in mentioned throughout his ministry.

WEDNESDAY

Read 1 Corinthians 16:13 again. Now go back and read 7:5, 9; 9:25; 15:1-2; 3:1; 13:11; and 14:20.

Does this command make sense now?

THURSDAY

Go back and read 1 Corinthians again.

Can you track through Paul's argument in the letter?

FRIDAY

Make a list of problems that the church of Corinth was dealing with in the first century that the church still struggles with today.

How did Paul address those issues?

Are his words still relevant today?
