

# Daniel 12:1-4

<sup>1</sup> " At that time ***shall arise Michael***, the great prince who has charge of your people. And there shall be ***a time of trouble, such as never has been since there was a nation till that time***. But at that time ***your people shall be delivered***, everyone whose name shall be found written in the book. <sup>2</sup> And many of ***those who sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake, some to everlasting life, and some to shame and everlasting contempt.***

# Daniel 12:1-4

<sup>3</sup> And those who are ***wise shall shine*** like the brightness of the sky above; ***and those who turn many to righteousness***, like the stars forever and ever. <sup>4</sup> But you, Daniel, shut up the words and ***seal the book, until the time of the end. Many shall run to and fro, and knowledge shall increase.***"



# Matthew 24:15-22

<sup>15</sup> " So when you see the abomination of desolation spoken of by the prophet Daniel, standing in the holy place (***let the reader understand***), <sup>16</sup> ***then let those who are in Judea flee to the mountains.*** <sup>17</sup> Let the one who is on the housetop not go down to take what is in his house, <sup>18</sup> and let the one who is in the field not turn back to take his cloak. <sup>19</sup> And alas for women who are pregnant and for those who are nursing infants in those days!

# Matthew 24:15-22

<sup>20</sup> Pray that your flight may not be in winter or on a Sabbath. <sup>21</sup> For then ***there will be great tribulation, such as has not been from the beginning of the world until now, no, and never will be.*** <sup>22</sup> ***And if those days had not been cut short, no human being would be saved.*** But for the sake of the elect those days will be cut short.

# 2 Corinthians 4:7-12

<sup>7</sup> But we have this treasure in jars of clay, to show that the surpassing power belongs to God and not to us. <sup>8</sup> *We are afflicted in every way, but not crushed; perplexed, but not driven to despair; <sup>9</sup> persecuted, but not forsaken; struck down, but not destroyed; <sup>10</sup> always carrying in the body the death of Jesus, so that the life of Jesus may also be manifested in our bodies.*



# 2 Corinthians 4:7-12

<sup>11</sup> For we who live are always being given over to death for Jesus' sake, so that the life of Jesus also may be manifested in our mortal flesh. <sup>12</sup> So *death is at work in us, but life in you.*

# Daniel 12:5-13

<sup>5</sup> Then I, Daniel, looked, and behold, two others stood, one on this bank of the stream and one on that bank of the stream. <sup>6</sup> And someone said to the man clothed in linen, who was above the waters of the stream, "How long shall it be till the end of these wonders?" <sup>7</sup> And I heard the man clothed in linen, who was above the waters of the stream;

# Daniel 12:5-13

he raised his right hand and his left hand toward heaven and swore by him who lives forever that ***it would be for a time, times, and half a time***, and that when the shattering of the power of the holy people comes to an end all these things would be finished. <sup>8</sup> I heard, but I did not understand. Then I said, "O my lord, what shall be the outcome of these things?" <sup>9</sup> He said, "Go your way, Daniel, for the words are shut up and sealed until the time of the end.



# Daniel 12:5-13

<sup>10</sup> *Many shall purify themselves and make themselves white and be refined*, but the wicked shall act wickedly. And none of the wicked shall understand, but those who are wise shall understand. <sup>11</sup> And from the time that the regular burnt offering is taken away and the abomination that makes desolate is set up, there shall be 1,290 days. <sup>12</sup> Blessed is he who waits and arrives at the 1,335 days.

# Daniel 12:5-13

<sup>13</sup> But go your way till the end. And **you shall rest and shall stand in your allotted place at the end of the days.**



## 2 Corinthians 4:16-18

<sup>16</sup> So we do not lose heart. Though our outer self is wasting away, our inner self is being renewed day by day. <sup>17</sup> For this light ***momentary affliction is preparing for us an eternal weight of glory beyond all comparison,*** <sup>18</sup> as we look not to the things that are seen but to the things that are unseen. For the things that are seen are transient, but the ***things that are unseen are eternal.***

# Hebrews 10:32-39

<sup>32</sup> But recall the former days when, after you were enlightened, ***you endured a hard struggle with sufferings,*** <sup>33</sup> ***sometimes being publicly exposed to reproach and affliction,*** and sometimes being partners with those so treated. <sup>34</sup> For you had compassion on those in prison, and you joyfully accepted the plundering of your property, ***since you knew that you yourselves had a better possession and an abiding one.***



# Hebrews 10:32-39

***35 Therefore do not throw away your confidence, which has a great reward.***

**36** For you have need of endurance, so that when you have done the will of God you may receive what is promised. **37** For, "Yet a little while, and the coming one will come and will not delay; **38** but my righteous one shall live by faith, and if he shrinks back, my soul has no pleasure in him."

# Hebrews 10:32-39

***39 But we are not of those who shrink back and are destroyed, but of those who have faith and preserve their souls.***
