Part 6: The Organization of the Community (Healthy Leadership)



¹ Now in these days when the disciples were increasing in number, a complaint by the Hellenists arose against the Hebrews because their widows were being neglected in the daily distribution. 2 And the twelve summoned the full number of the disciples and said, "It is not right that we should give up preaching the word of God to serve tables.



³ Therefore, brothers, pick out from among you seven men of good repute, full of the Spirit and of wisdom, whom we will appoint to this duty. 4 But we will devote ourselves to prayer and to the ministry of the word." 5 And what they said pleased the whole gathering, and they chose Stephen, a man full of faith and of the Holy Spirit, and Philip, and Prochorus, and Nicanor, and Timon, and Parmenas, and Nicolaus, a proselyte of Antioch.

- ⁶ These they set before the apostles, and they prayed and laid their hands on them.
- ⁷ And the word of God continued to increase, and the number of the disciples multiplied greatly in Jerusalem, and a great many of the priests became obedient to the faith.





Without Organization Things Get Neglected (vv. 1-2)



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Two Outcomes from Healthy Organization:

- 1. People are cared for
- 2. People's gifts are released



Organization Requires Healthy Leadership (vv. 3-5)



Acts 6:3-5

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Question: Can you be a gifted leader and yet not a healthy person?

Leadership is about influence.



Question: So what wisdom does scripture give to help identify a healthy leader?

- 3 Qualities of a Healthy Leader (v. 3)



1. Committed to the community-" from among you"

- "from among you" implies their relational investment in this community
- "from among you" implies their personal identification with this community



2. Willing to be accountable to others- "of good repute"

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James 3:1

¹"Not many of you should become teachers, my brothers, for you know that we who teach will be judged with greater strictness."





3. Spirit-controlled lifestyle - "full of the Spirit & of wisdom"

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Question: If the Holy Spirit is invisible how can we know if someone is full of Him or not?



Healthy Leaders Help Communities Flourish (v. 6-7)



Acts 6:6-7

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- And the word of God continued to increase, and the number of the disciples multiplied greatly in Jerusalem, and a great many of the priests became obedient to the faith.

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Two signs of a flourishing community:

- God's word increases in influence in our lives
- 2. Increasing #s of people committing to follow the ways of Jesus

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
