What is hope really?



Hope is a positive or optimistic expectation for something good in the future.



Biblical hope is a confident expectation for something good based on God's promises.



Luke 2:25-28

²⁵ Now there was a man in Jerusalem, whose name was Simeon, and this man was righteous and devout, waiting for the consolation of Israel, and the Holy Spirit was upon him. 26 And it had been revealed to him by the Holy Spirit that he would not see death before he had seen the Lord's Christ. ²⁷ And he came in the Spirit into the temple, and when the parents brought in the child Jesus, to do for him according to the custom of the Law, 28 hers took him up in his arms and blessed God and said,
