



Have you ever heard God's voice but still needed confirmation before taking action?




Have you ever had someone share a word with you that confirmed what you thought God might be saying?




Acts 20:22-24

²² And now, behold, I am going to Jerusalem, constrained by the Spirit, not knowing what will happen to me there, ²³ except that the Holy Spirit testifies to me in every city that imprisonment and afflictions await me. 24 But I do not account my life of any value nor as precious to myself, if only I may finish my course and the ministry that I received from the Lord Jesus, to testify to the gospel of the grace of God

⁸ On the next day we departed and came to Caesarea, and we entered the house of Philip the evangelist, who was one of the seven, and stayed with him. ⁹ He had four unmarried daughters, **who** prophesied. 10 While we were staying for many days, a prophet named Agabus came down from Judea. 11 And coming to us, he took Paul's belt and bound his own feet and hands and said,

"Thus says the Holy Spirit, 'This is how the Jews at Jerusalem will bind the man who owns this belt and deliver him into the hands of the Gentiles.' " 12 When we heard this, we and the people there urged him not to go up to Jerusalem. 13 Then Paul answered, "What are you doing, weeping and breaking my heart?




Acts 21:8-14

14 And since he would not be persuaded, we ceased and said, "Let the will of the Lord be done."




Confirmation Through Others




1 Corinthians 12:1-11

Now concerning spiritual gifts, brothers, I do not want you to be uninformed. ² You know that when you were pagans you were led astray to mute idols, however you were led. ³ Therefore I want you to understand that no one speaking in the Spirit of God ever says "Jesus is accursed!" and no one can say "Jesus is Lord" except in the Holy Spirit.




1 Corinthians 12:1-11

4 Now there are varieties of gifts, but the same Spirit; ⁵ and there are varieties of service, but the same Lord; 6 and there are varieties of activities, but it is the same God who empowers them all in everyone. ⁷ To each is given the manifestation of the Spirit for the common good. 8 For to one is given through the Spirit the utterance of wisdom, and to another the utterance of knowledge according to the same Spirit,



1 Corinthians 12:1-11

9 to another faith by the same Spirit, to another gifts of healing by the one Spirit, 10 to another the working of miracles, to another prophecy, to another the ability to distinguish between spirits, to another various kinds of tongues, to another the interpretation of tongues. 11 All these are empowered by one and the same Spirit, who apportions to each one individually as he wills.




What if someone is not hearing God?




Romans 12:6

¹⁹ Do not quench the Spirit. ²⁰ **Do not despise prophecies**, ²¹ but **test everything**; **hold fast what is good**.




How to test a word:

- 1. Is it biblical?
- 2. Is this a confirmation of something I've been talking with the Lord about?



How to test a word:

- 3. Does this produce faith, peace, joy, or love in my soul?
- 4. Ask the Lord if there is anything to hold on to.
