Galatians 6:1-5

¹ Brothers, if anyone is caught in any transgression, you who are spiritual should restore him in a spirit of gentleness. Keep watch on yourself, lest you too be tempted. ² Bear one another's burdens, and so fulfill the law of Christ. ³ For if anyone thinks he is something, when he is nothing, he deceives himself.

Galatians 6:1-5

⁴ But let each one test his own work, and then his reason to boast will be in himself alone and not in his neighbor. ⁵ For each will have to bear his own load.

Transgression Crossing over a boundary set by God

Restore:

- bring back (a previous right, practice, or situation); reinstate
 - return to a former condition or position
- 2. repair or renovate
- 3. give (something stolen or removed) back to the original owner

6 Ways to Keep A Grace-filled Heart:

- 1. Beware of putting grades on sin.
- Keep restoration the goal: relationships, & calling.
- 3. Make loving your neighbor as yourself the lens.
- 4. Use grace to shield your heart from the fallout.
- 5. Remember how frail you are and how many transgressions you've had.
- 6. Walk by the Spirit not by pressure.

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
