Romans 8

³¹ What then shall we say to these things? If God is for us, who can be against us? ³² He who did not spare his own Son but gave him up for us all, how will he not also with him graciously give us all things? ³³ Who shall bring any charge against God's elect? It is God who justifies. ³⁴ Who is to condemn? Christ Jesus is the one who died – more than that, who was raised – who is at the right hand of God, who indeed is interceding for us.

Romans 8

³⁵ Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or danger, or sword?

³⁶ As it is written, "For your sake we are being killed all the day long; we are regarded as sheep to be slaughtered."

God Never Stops Loving You

Romans 8

³⁷ No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us. ³⁸ For I am sure that neither death nor life, nor angels nor rulers, nor things present nor things to come, nor powers, ³⁹ nor height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord.

God Never Stops Loving You

How do I re-center in God's love?

- 1) Listen: What is God saying about who you are to Him?
- 2) Learn: What did you need to be reminded or alerted to?
- 3) Lean: What can you believe God for in this?
- 4) Let Go: What are you trying to control that needs to be surrendered?

- 1) What words would you use to describe God's feelings toward you? Is He happy, disappointed, proud, embarrassed...?
- 2) When did you battle insecurities this week and how did you handle it?
- 3) What have you believed about God's feelings toward you in hard times?
