

# Daniel 9:1-2

In the first year of Darius the son of Ahasuerus, by descent a Mede, who was made king over the realm of the Chaldeans—<sup>2</sup> in the first year of his reign, I, Daniel, ***perceived in the books the number of years that, according to the word of the Lord to Jeremiah the prophet, must pass before the end of the desolations of Jerusalem, namely, seventy years.***

# Jeremiah 25:11

<sup>11</sup> This whole land shall become a ruin and a waste, and these nations shall serve the king of Babylon ***seventy years.***

**1. Own our sin & its consequence (3-12)**

# Daniel 9:3-12

<sup>3</sup> Then *I turned my face to the Lord God, seeking him by prayer and pleas for mercy with fasting and sackcloth and ashes.* <sup>4</sup> I prayed to the Lord my God and made confession, saying, "O Lord, the great and awesome God, who keeps covenant and steadfast love with those who love him and keep his commandments, <sup>5</sup> we have sinned and done wrong and acted wickedly and rebelled, turning aside from your commandments and rules.


# Daniel 9:3-12

<sup>6</sup> *We have not listened to your servants the prophets*, who spoke in your name to our kings, our princes, and our fathers, and to all the people of the land...

<sup>9</sup> *To the Lord our God belong mercy and forgiveness*, for we have rebelled against him <sup>10</sup> and have not obeyed the voice of the Lord our God by walking in his laws, which he set before us by his servants the prophets.

# Daniel 9:3-12

<sup>11</sup> All Israel has transgressed your law and turned aside, refusing to obey your voice. And ***the curse and oath that are written in the Law of Moses the servant of God have been poured out upon us, because we have sinned against him...***




**2. *Ask for His forgiveness & favor (13)***



# Daniel 9:13


"As it is written in the Law of Moses, all this calamity has come upon us; ***yet we have not entreated the favor of the Lord our God, turning from our iniquities and gaining insight by your truth.***"

**3. *Be confident in His character (18-19)***

# Daniel 9:18-19

<sup>18</sup> O my God, incline your ear and hear. Open your eyes and see our desolations, and the city that is called by your name. ***For we do not present our pleas before you because of our righteousness, but because of your great mercy.*** <sup>19</sup> O Lord, hear; O Lord, forgive. O Lord, pay attention and act. Delay not, for your own sake, O my God, because your city and your people are called by your name."



***“Cold prayers ask God to deny them: only importunate prayers will be replied to. When the Church of God cannot take ‘No’ for an answer, she shall not have ‘No’ for an answer. When a pleading soul must have it; when the Spirit of God works mightily in him so that he cannot let the angel go without a blessing, the angel shall not go till he has given the blessing to such a pleading one. Brethren, if there be only one among us that can pray as Daniel did, with intensity, the blessing will come.” -Spurgeon***

# ***1. Time to Build Up***





# Daniel 9:25

25 Know therefore and understand that from the going out of the word to restore and build Jerusalem to the coming of an anointed one, a prince, there shall be seven weeks.



## **2. *Time to Bow Down***



# Daniel 9:26

Then for sixty-two weeks it shall be built again with squares and moat, but in a troubled time. 26 And after the sixty-two weeks, an anointed one shall be cut off and shall have nothing. And the people of the prince who is to come shall destroy the city and the sanctuary. Its end shall come with a flood, and to the end there shall be war. Desolations are decreed.



### **3. *Time to Bow Out***



# Daniel 9:27

27 And he shall make a strong covenant with many for one week, and for half of the week he shall put an end to sacrifice and offering. And on the wing of abominations shall come one who makes desolate, until the decreed end is poured out on the desolator."
