



Last Word: WEEK 2

1. How does today's LAST WORD of Jesus impact you personally?
2. Read Luke 15:1-7 and 19:1-10. What do these passages say about Jesus and his ministry? What does it tell you about people? Do you have the same heart as Jesus does for the least, lost, and lonely? How do you think non-believers see these teachings lived out in the church today?
3. Read Luke 23:35-43. Jesus told the dying criminal that he would be with Him TODAY. The offer from Jesus is that every day is today if you pursue a relationship with Him. Why is it so hard for us to embrace Jesus in our everyday life and recognize He is with us? What is one way you can begin to live out His being "with" you in the everyday...today?
4. Jesus' offering of TODAY, every day, is also an offer to the least, lost, and last in our circles of influence. Pastor Dan shared that cultivating a deep, steady, resilient Christian conviction for evangelism is difficult in a world of 'you do you' and 'don't criticize anyone's life choices' culture, but the Church MUST embrace our call to evangelize. Dan also shared that almost half of polled millennials feel it's wrong to evangelize others. How do you feel about Evangelism? Do you find it challenging/easy? Share ideas on how you can grow in your practice/confidence of sharing the gospel and pray for lost people in each other's lives.
