- 3. Read Rev. 3:8b. How can you have little strength and yet keep God's word? Describe a time when this has been the case for you.
- 4. Read Rev. 3:10. Dan explained the interpretative ambiguity and disagreement of whether Jesus' promise is to deliver from or through trials. Regardless of your favored interpretation, how does God protect us in trials? We know that he allows us to have trouble and suffering, so what does his protection and provision look like? How do you find hope in this verse?
- 5. Read Rev. 3:11-12, Rev. 21:1-7. How does your expectation of the coming kingdom of God change how you live your life now?
- 6. Pastor Dan said three things he saw in this passage that invite a response; 1) The door is open, 2) Victory is sure, 3) The Kingdom has come and is coming. Which of these three is Jesus asking you to respond to this week?
