Questions for your Family Devotions or Grace Groups:

- 1. Review 1 Timothy 6:12. What was something the Lord used to speak to you personally in this message?
- 2. In the story of Esther, the initial law to destroy the Jews on March 13th, written by Haman, could not be undone, however, a new law was made that allowed the Jews **to defend** themselves. They were overjoyed about this? Why? How does the following quote relate to YOUR life today: "God didn't keep them from battle, but He now gave them HOPE in the battle"?
- 3. Read Ezekiel 18:20 and Romans 6:23. What is the "law" that cannot be 'undone'... and what provision has the Lord made to 'save' those who believe in Him?
- 4. Pastor Michael talked about the story of D-Day and likened it to what occurred on Calvary. What does it mean that Satan was defeated that day by what Jesus accomplished on the Cross, and yet he still wages war against the saints?
- Read the following Scriptures and discuss what they mean as they relate to the FIGHT we're all in: 2 Corinthians 10:3-5, James 4:7, 1 Peter 5:8, Luke 10:19, Isaiah 54:17, Ephesians 6:11, 1 John 5:4.
