



Summary of Message:

What can keep a Christian's heart from becoming hardened? Our text tells us it can be a "lack of remembering".

What are we supposed to be remembering? And how does the answer Jesus gives to a sincere question from the disciples in Luke chapter 11 relate?

Questions for your Family Devotions or Grace Groups:

1. Review **Mark 8:11-21**. What was something the Lord used to speak to **you personally** in this message?
2. If you could ask anything of Jesus, what would you ask Him for?
3. In **Mark 8:12**, why did Jesus "sigh deeply"? In what ways today do people miss the moving of God all around them?
4. **Romans 10:7 (NKJV)** – *So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God*. Discuss what this verse is really saying. If this verse is accurate, then why is it that many people's faith is so very weak today?
5. **Mark 8:16a** states of the disciples, "*They were discussing among themselves*". Read **James 1:5** and **Proverbs 3:5-6**. Why would it seem that so many today would rather sit around and "discuss", than seek God's will and heart by studying His Word or praying together? When seeking God's perfect will for something, how do you go about finding it?
6. What are some ways God can "feed us daily bread," both Physically & Spiritually? [**Philippians 4:19**, **Jeremiah 15:16**, **Romans 8:32**]
