- 3. **Read John 15:1-8** What does it mean for us if we only have to remain in Jesus to produce fruit? Notice it never commands us to produce fruit. Does this make it easier or more freeing for you as you move towards being a more accurate reflection of Jesus?
- 4. **Read Matthew 15:8** What does your heart look like? Is Sunday morning the only time are spending time with Jesus? Do we just follow the rules to look the part or are we following the rules because we know Jesus so well.
- 5. **Read Psalm 19:7-14** If God's Words are so good for so many things why do we not take time to be in the word.
- 7. What steps can you take to know Jesus better? Who in your life can help to accomplish your goals?
