

Questions to help you dig deeper into the message for your Grace Group or family devotions:

- 1. Read **Ruth 1:1-5**. Share what stood out and ministered to you most from this message?
- 2. Read Judges 21:25. Talk about what this climate must have been like in these days. What similarities do we see in our own culture to this description?
- 3. It was mentioned that "God is my King" always dies in Moab and is closely followed by the "song" of our hearts and the "satisfaction" of our souls. Have you found this to be true? Talk about a time when you didn't 'stay at home' in the Word and in worship and took a season in Moab. What brought you back?
- 4. Read **Psalm 119:171**. Discuss the quote from Pastor Michael, "A person who is learning about the ways of God and the character of God through the Word of God cannot help but overflow in praise to God." What does this look like practically for us? (*daily devotions, church attendance, fellowship with believers*)
- 5. Read Amos 8:11. Have you experienced this type of famine? When? How did you get out of it... if you did?
- 6. Read Isaiah 43:2-3. Why would God want to walk 'with' us through times like this and NOT have us seek to run away from them (Romans 5:3-5)?
