



Questions for your Family Devotions or Grace Groups:

Summary of Message, “FAITH”:

Faith looks back. Faith tells me Jesus came. Faith allows me to embrace what Jesus did for me on the Cross. Faith reminds me that my sins are forgiven. Therefore, I don't have to worry about or be haunted by my past. But the journey towards authentic faith may look different with different people. Are questions okay? Is having doubts okay?

1. Read [Luke 1:26-38](#) and [Luke 1:41-49](#). What was something the Lord used to speak to **you personally** in this message?
2. If you are married talk about how your engagement went down. Was it different than a traditional Jewish engagement in Jesus' time? How would Mary have felt sharing the news with her parents? With her friends? With her fiancé? Do you think ANYONE understood her?
3. What two types of doubts can people have? How does [Proverbs 3:5-6](#) relate to someone who has questions?
4. What are your thoughts on what Pastor Michael stated; *“Unless you've heard the Christian message and at some point found it to be impossible and a little nuts... I'm not sure you have ever really grasped it. If you've never stood and looked at the Gospel and found it ridiculous, impossible, inconceivable, I don't think you have really understood it.”*
5. Who in your life is a skeptic about the things of God? What are some ways for that person to begin a journey towards faith in Christ? What is their biggest barrier? Pray for that person with your group.
