

## Questions for your Family Devotions or Grace Groups:

## **Summary of Message:**

Jesus went to His hometown and encountered so much unbelief there that He was unable to do many miracles. Unbelief can be hazardous to your health in three ways: **It blinds eyes and you can become skeptical, It poisons your heart and you can become cynical, and it robs your joy and you can become sterile**. Is there an antidote? Absolutely!

- 1. Review Mark 6:1-6. What was something the Lord used to speak to you personally in this message?
- 2. How does your family react to your faith in Christ? How does that affect you? Read Matthew 19:29-30 & discuss what Jesus *might be* talking about.
- 3. Why do you think Jesus stated, "A prophet is not without honor except in his hometown, among his relatives, and in his household."? How has familiarity with Jesus blocked you from really seeing who He is? What helps you get a fresh look?
- 4. Read Psalm 14:1. Why is it "foolish" to say there is no God? Discuss the statement Pastor Michael made: "If God proved His existence, we couldn't truly be a 'believer', we could be a 'follower', but not a 'believer', because there would be no faith required." Why does God desire us to have 'faith'? (Hebrews 11:6)
- 5. Three 'cures' were given for unbelief when it raises its ugly head. Talk about each of them:
  - Offer prayer to God Ephesians 1:18, 2 Kings 6:17
  - See people 'in' God 2 Corinthians 5:16a
  - Speak the promises of God Romans 10:8-9, Matthew 17:20
