



## Questions to help you dig deeper into the message for your Grace Groups or Family Devotions:

1. Read [Ruth 2:1-4](#). Discuss what stood out and ministered to you most from this message?
2. Read [Deuteronomy 24:18-19](#). What is God's heart for the poor? What should our heart for the poor be? Read the following passages and discuss: [Leviticus 25:35-36](#), [Psalm 82:3-4](#), [Proverbs 14:21](#), [Proverbs 29:7](#), [Matthew 25:40](#), [Luke 14:12-14](#).
3. Ruth just *"happened"* to be in the right place at the right time. What appears to us as random chance is in fact overseen by a sovereign God who knows the number of hairs on every head ([Luke 12:7](#)). Jesus said that not even a sparrow falls to the ground without our Father's notice ([Matthew 10:29](#)). Why is it important for the follower of Christ to **believe** and **know** this?
4. The following statement was made: *"Simply walk day by day in the Way, and, as He did Abraham's servant, and as He did for Ruth... God will lead you."* Discuss what this means, and what it would look like practically for someone to *"simply walk in the Way"*. (Bonus question: In what ways does God 'lead' us today?)
5. God has ALWAYS desired to walk with us ([Genesis 3:8](#), [Deuteronomy 23:14](#), [John 1:14](#), [Philippians 2:5-8](#)), but man has not always desired to walk with Him. It was stated, however, that one day all men will ([Philippians 2:9-11](#)). What is something Christians can do today to help all people desire a relationship with God now?
