



## Questions to help you dig deeper into the message for your Grace Groups or Family Devotions:

1. Share something that stood out to you or ministered to you from this message.
2. Read [Ruth 2:1](#). Boaz' name means, "***standing in strength***" and this verse states he was a '*relative*'. It was shared that there are two Hebrew words for '*relative*' that are used in the Book of Ruth and those words can be translated, "*kinsman*", "*deliverer*", "*avenger*", and "*redeemer*". Knowing this, how does Boaz perfectly picture Jesus Christ? What does the '**year of Jubilee**' have to do with it?
3. Read [Colossians 2:13-14](#). There are 5 things these verses describe that Jesus has done for us. Discuss each of these and what they mean, then talk about what this means for us today, living in 2023.
4. Read [Luke 24:27](#). What is happening in this verse (*what's the context*)? What advantage is it to us to see Jesus pictured throughout the Bible? Why would it be important for us to get glimpses of Who Jesus is?
5. Read [Luke 7:47](#). What did Jesus mean when He stated, "the one who is forgiven little, loves little"? In what ways do people "love Jesus little" today? Why?
