- 1. What was your favorite subject to study in school? What was your least?
- 2. Read **Rev. 2:18**. Compare this description of Christ with **Daniel 3:8-30**. What similarities are there? How is the context of Daniel 3 and the witnessing church similar? Putting it all together, what are we being told about Christ in verse 18?
- 3. **Read verse 19**. What is the church at Thyatira commended for? What does 'how your latter works exceed the first' mean? Hint: Compare this to the church in Ephesus in **Revelation 2:5**. So what is the main difference between the Ephesian church and the 'Thyatirian' church?
- 4. Read **1 Kings 21** in order to understand the reference to Jezebel. Why does Christ refer to the woman in Revelation 2:20 as Jezebel? Jesus attempted to discipline Jezebel by giving clear time for her to repent, he also gave the Church time to discipline her yet they didn't. Read **Heb. 12:8-11**, why does God discipline us in our daily lives, what is his purpose?
- 5. What does it mean to **hold fast** (Rev. 2:25)? Dan said holding fast today means "majoring on the majors" what are some of the key teachings of the church that you believe must be taught, retaught, and essential to faith? What resources could you use to reinforce the areas where you need to hold fast?
- 6. **Read Rev. 2:19**. What did Jesus affirm Thyatira for in the first part of the verse? Why do you think these specific areas were important to Jesus? Jesus also affirmed in v 19 that the church kept growing. Why is it important that we keep growing in our faith? Read **1 Thess. 5:23-24**. Looking again at Jesus' commendation in Rev. 2:19 give an example of one area where Jesus has helped you grow (hint: works, love, faith, service, or patience endurance).
