Let's begin by exploring the very central question of ______ itself! (Ac 17:16-34)

- This question has invited indifference, intrigue, debate, speculation, mockery, and confusion for 2,000 years.
- This question has been debated, contested, and misunderstood for 2,000 years. Ignore it at your own peril!

Who do you say ______ is? (Mt 16:13-15)

How we answer this Q determines whether we can have ______ or not! In the here and now!

• "Tell me more, Pastor!" Sure. But first, let's explore in our main passage how Jesus Himself answers the question.

John 12:37-50... In verses 44-50, Jesus Himself answers the question as to who He is.

- VV 44-45... "Whoever believes in Me also believes in _____. When you look at Me, you're looking at God." Heb 1:3
- VV 47-48... "I came to ______ you. If you reject Me, you'll be condemned." Jn 3:16-18
- VV 49-50... "My words are God's words. Heed them and receive ______." 1 Jn 5:11-12

In summary, the textbook answer to the central question of life itself is the following:

Jesus is 1) Eternal God 2) Savior of the World, and 3) Giver of Life!

"Wow, tell me more!" Sure, happy to be of service. Below are some verses to support these radical claims about Jesus.

1) Eternal _____. Jn 10:10; Jn 8:58; Ex 3:14 → Ac 20:28; Heb 1:8

a. Jesus was born without a sin nature \rightarrow His death was an acceptable sacrifice for the sins of the world. – 1 Jn 2:2

2) ______ of the world. Ro 5:12; Eccl 7:20; Psa 51:5; Eph 2:1 → Jn 4:42; 1 Jn 4:14; Ac 4:12; Jn 14:6

a. I was a dead man walking! - Eph 2:1-3

3) Giver of ______ (Gr. Zoe "Zoh-AY"). Jn 3:16; Jn 5:24; Ro 6:23; 1 Jn 5:13; Mt 25:46

a. I was made alive! – Eph 2:4-5

"Awesome! But... so what? In other words, what do I do with this ?" Assuming that you have been "made alive..."

Now that you know the answer to the Q, "Who do you say Jesus is?" SET A GOAL THIS WEEK TO ASK SOMEONE THIS QUESTION! (You should desire to do so. This is a characteristic of your new nature - Col 3:1-17.)

There are people that God placed in your life who don't believe what the Bible teaches about Jesus.

That said, here are some tips regarding being a witness. (Ac 1:8)

- 1. We are _____ called to judge those who are not followers of Jesus. (1 Cor 5:9-13)
- 2. By not judging, we are, in essence, ______ the feet of sinners. Actually, Jesus is doing so through us. (Rom 8:9; Matt 11:19; Rom 2:4; Jn 6:44)
- 3. By applying points 1 and 2 above, an unsaved person would naturally ______ about our faith. (1 Pet 3:15) This, of course, opens the door to share John 3:16, the Gospel message.

And in response...

Ask the question, "Who do you think Jesus is?" ii. Share John 3:16 iii. Google together "Lewis' Trilemma," iv. Ask, "Do you believe this?" If yes, then Google "The Sinner's Prayer." If no, then no worries. Pray the father will draw them, v. Invite them to come with you to church!

THE MEANING OF "ETERNAL LIFE" IN JOHN 3:16; JOHN 5:24; ROMANS 6:23; 1 JOHN 5:13; MATT 25:46

The Greek word is *Zoe* (pronounced "zoh-AY"). Zoe is defined as the absolute fullness of life. A life active and vigorous, devoted to God, blessed immeasurably in the here and now for those who put their absolute trust in Christ!
