Dan Kahan, a Yale law professor, recently led a study that found that our passions and biases undermine even basic reasoning. The study showed that people who are normally very adept at math are suddenly unable to solve a problem when the obvious answer conflicts with their political beliefs.

And its not as if the "smart" people were able to do better at solving the problems. In fact, the researchers found that the better the people were at math, the more apt they were to try to avoid the actual answer. (This applied to both liberals and conservatives by the way.) Instead of changing our beliefs to match reality, we often just rearrange reality, in our heads, to match what we want.¹
