 NorthPointe is a gospel-centered church that aims to make, mature and multiply disciples of Jesus Christ.


Matthew 28:18-20

• The great commission is not, strictly speaking, a command to discipleship...it's a command to disciple making.


"The things which you have heard from me in the presence of many witnesses, entrust these to faithful people who will be able to teach others also."(2 Tim. 2:2)

Could you disciple 1 person who goes out and disciples 1 person and so on? Yes!
