**Maudy Thursday Tenebrae service** at CCC



The Tenebrae, sometimes called “service of darkness” or “service of shadows” takes place on any of the last three days of Jesus’ life: Maundy Thursday, Good Friday or Saturday. The service begins being well lit. As Scripture passages concerning Christ’s suffering are read, candles are gradually extinguished. The service is a meditative experience reflecting on our Lord’s pain and suffering on our behalf. The service ends in darkness and silence. We will also celebrate the Lord’s Supper together.
