"Remembering Matters" Luke 22 and 1 Corinthians 11

Main Idea: Communion is an invitation to remember Jesus, return to Jesus, and remain in Jesus.

Communion

Jesus instructed His followers to remember Him. Not because He needs to be remembered — but because we need to remember. We forget easily. Life gets loud. We drift. We lose clarity. Communion is Jesus' built-in rhythm to pull our hearts back to center. It's His invitation to pause, reflect, and remember what matters most.

Why Remember?

Communion is Jesus' antidote to spiritual amnesia. It's the spiritual pause button in a world that refuses to pause. It's His way of saying: "Don't forget Me — and don't forget what I've done for you." Remembering is important.

What Should We Do?

- 1. Remember Jesus (Luke 22:19). Jesus broke the bread and said, "Do this in remembrance of Me." He did not ask us to remember His miracles, parables, or debates though all were important. He asked us to remember His sacrifice. When we remember the cross, we remember that...Love became visible, Grace became personal, and Salvation became possible.
- **2. Return to Jesus (1 Corinthians 11:28).** Paul wrote, "Everyone ought to examine themselves..." Self-examination is not shame it's like coming home. It is Jesus saying: "You've drifted. Come back to grace. Come back to who I made you to be." Communion is not a ritual to perform; it is a relationship to renew.
- **3. Remain in Jesus (Luke 22:20).** Jesus spoke of a new covenant a new way of relating to God. It is a covenant based not on performance, rules, or ritual, but on faith. Communion reminds us that Jesus is enough.

Communion is an Invitation to...

- □ **Remember** His sacrifice
- □ **Return** from drifting
- □ Remain in Him daily

- ✓ Pause intentionally and remember the cross
- ✓ Examine your heart honestly before God
- ✓ Choose one habit that helps you remain in Jesus Scripture, prayer, worship, gratitude

Family Night - Read Luke 22:14-20

- **Elementary School:** Ask, "What did Jesus ask His followers to remember? What do the bread and cup represent? Why do we sometimes forget important things Jesus has done?"
- **Middle / High School:** Ask, "Why do you think Jesus wants us to remember His sacrifice over everything else He taught and accomplished? How can someone your age "remain in Jesus" this week?"

Prayer: "Lord Jesus, help us remember Your sacrifice, return to Your grace, and remain in You. Amen."
