# NU-ME 03: "Others" Philippians 1

Main Idea: Personal sacrifice brings others along and enables them to be used of God.

#### **NU-ME Series**

NU-ME is NOT a series about resolution making. NU-ME is about real-life change. You can change. Your family dynamic can change. Your marriage can improve. You can be better, do better, become better in 2023.

### **Achievers and Others**

Achievers can see the goal (whatever it is) and pursue it, but achievers often lose sight of their own influence on others around them. One of the most underrated and ignored qualities of **spiritual maturity is sacrifice** (i.e. service and loyalty to others). That is revolutionary and another distinguishing characteristic of Christianity setting it apart from other world religions. Followers of Jesus Christ are called to help others (Mark 12:30-31).

### **Personal Sacrifice**

Personal sacrifice can be a hard pill to swallow. To sacrifice is to forfeit or surrender something rightfully ours, and few achievers find this appealing. Just remember – very often the Bible links sacrifice with blessing (see 1Peter 4:13). Pain often brings gain. Simply put, if your life is without some measure of sacrifice, you may be achieving, but it will be without blessing.

#### Think About It...

An achiever's sacrifice enables others to be greatly used of God. Jonathan demonstrated this principle as did Paul. We could examine the lives of others as well like **Abraham**, **Joseph**, **Rahab**, **Daniel**, **Esther**, **Jeremiah**, **and Barnabas**. The Bible is filled with examples of sacrifice because it is God's way to sacrifice. **How about you?** 

- 1. Sacrifice is an opportunity to glorify God. When we achieve we glorify ourselves. When we achieve and remember others, bring others along, sacrifice for others, we glorify God.
- 2. Sacrifice is an opportunity to encourage others. Whatever we accomplish in this life, we owe much of it to the people who sacrificed for us. They encouraged us. They brought us along.
- 3. Sacrifice is never ignored by God. It is God's way to sacrifice. Sacrifice leads to the blessing.

### **Family Night Big Idea**

You want your children to understand their own selfish bent. Teach unselfishness in your home. We honor God when we remember, serve, and sacrifice for others.

## **Discussion Starter - Read Philippians 1:12-26**

- **Elementary School** Ask, "Why was Paul "in chains" (v.13)?" Ask, "Who (or what) was Paul's life about (v.21)?" Ask, "What do you sometimes do that is selfish?"
- **Middle/ High School** Ask, "What motivated Paul while he was in prison?" Ask, "How did Paul's ministry differ from other selfish ministers (vv.15-17)?" Ask, "What is Paul saying in vv.20-21?"
