One generation commends your works to another; they tell of your mighty acts
- Psalm 145:4 (NIV)

One of the ways we can Impact Tomorrow Today is by setting goals. Setting goals is essential to Impacting Tomorrow Today because:

1) Setting Goals is a Spiritual Obligation

By nature, we are a goal-oriented people, and as we grow spiritually we must realize that our spiritual journey is continuous. We are not yet where God calls us to be, so we have an obligation (a spiritual obligation) to set goals which are pleasing to God, and grow where He calls us to grow.

I know that <u>I am not yet what God wants me to be</u>. I haven't reached <u>that goal</u> yet. But, I keep moving toward it to make it mine because Christ made me and saved me for this. I know that I haven't yet reached <u>my goal</u>, but there's one thing I always do; forgetting the past and straining toward what lies ahead, I keep my eyes focused on <u>the goal</u> so that I may one day win the prize that God has called me to receive through Christ in the life above. And all of us who are spiritually mature, should think this same way too - Philippians 3:12-14 (MSG)

2) Setting goals is a Declaration Of My Faith

When we set goals in faith we are professing: 'I believe that this goal is pleasing to God, and that God wants me to accomplish it. Setting goals stretches our faith. The bigger our goals, the more our faith will be tested. Without goals, there is no risk. Without risk, there is no need for faith. Without faith, it is impossible to please God.

Without faith it is impossible to please God - Hebrews 11:6 (NIV)

3) Setting goals Keeps Me Focused

Without goals, we tend to wander around in our day to day tasks and routines. But when we *do* set goals, we become more focused, which keeps us from wasting time, money, energy, and effort. The more focused we are, the more effective we become in our mission.

This is how I run; <u>not without a clear goal</u> in sight. I fight like a boxer in the ring, <u>not like someone who is shadowboxing</u> - 1 Corinthians 9:26 (CEB)

4) Setting goals Keeps Me Moving Ahead

As we strive to reach our goals, we are going to run into obstacles, and there will be times when we fall and fail. But, setting goals gives us hope to *persist* and *endure*, which keeps us from becoming discouraged when we experience setbacks.

I press on towards the goal... - Philippians 3:14 (NIV)

5) Setting goals Develops My Character

One of the greatest benefits we gain from setting goals is what takes place inside us: the development of our character. While we are working on reaching our goals, God is working on developing our character, and transforming us spiritually.

<u>Do not conform</u> to the pattern of this world, but <u>be transformed</u> by the renewing of your mind - Romans 12:2 (NIV)
