- We will visit the famous caves where the Dead Sea scrolls were found.
- And we will spend time floating on the Dead Sea.

Imagine seeing the same landscape that Jesus saw, being baptized in the Jordan River, having a communion service at Golgotha, or singing at the Garden Tomb where the Lord was raised from the dead.

ITINERARY



DAY 1 – MONDAY, MAY 7TH: DEPART U.S.A.

Tour members will meet for the flight to Israel. On the flight, we will enjoy dinner and the on-board entertainment as we prepare to walk where Jesus walked in a land that uniquely contrasts modern life with the ancient world.

DAY 2 – TUESDAY, MAY 8TH: SHALOM AND WELCOME TO ISRAEL!

Upon landing at Ben Gurion International Airport, we meet our guide and will be escorted to the bus waiting to take us to our hotel in nearby Netanya where we will check-in for dinner and spend the night.

DAY 3 – WEDNESDAY, MAY 9TH: CAESAREA, MEGIDDO, MT. CARMEL, DRUZE VILLAGE, GALILEE

This morning we will depart for Galilee, visiting biblical sites at Caesarea (where Peter proclaimed the “Good news” to the Roman Centurion - Acts 10), Megiddo, and Mt. Carmel (where Elijah confronted the prophets of Baal - 1 Kings 18). Time permitting, we’ll stop at the Druze Village for lunch. Then we will arrive in Tiberias for dinner and overnight on the shore of the Sea of Galilee.

DAY 4 – THURSDAY, MAY 10TH: GALILEE, TABGHA, KURSI, MT. OF BEATITUDES, CAPERNAUM, BOAT RIDE, NAZARETH, JORDAN RIVER

Nothing beats watching the sun rise over the Sea of Galilee! We will begin today at Tabgha (the traditional site where Christ met His disciples after the resurrection - John 21) and the Church of the Primacy of St. Peter. We will then spend time reflecting and worshipping at the Mt. of Beatitudes. Then we drive to the site of the Gadarenes (today called Kursi), where the Lord sent the demons into the herd of swine (Luke 8:26-40). Next, we will make our way to Capernaum, Jesus’ base for His early ministry, before seeing a replica wooden “Jesus Boat” and then setting sail on the Sea of Galilee. Our lunch stop includes the option of the special St. Peter’s Fish for those interested. After lunch, we continue to Nazareth (Jesus’ childhood home) and visit the “Nazareth Village” with a detailed explanation of what life was like during the time of Jesus. We will drive through Cana (location of Jesus’ first miracle - John 2) and stop at the Mt. of Precipice. Dinner and overnight will be back in Tiberias.

DAY 5 – FRIDAY, MAY 11TH: GOLAN HEIGHTS, BETHSAIDA-JULIUS, CAESAREA PHILIPPI, MAGDALA, BEIT SHEAN, JERUSALEM, SHABBAT OF A LIFETIME

After breakfast, we will travel north for the Golan Heights to view a beautiful landscape of northern Israel. We’ll sit on the Plain of Bethsaida where Jesus multiplied the fish and the loaves, reflecting on its powerful life applications. Then we will head to Caesarea Philippi where Peter confessed “You are the Messiah, the Son of the living God” (Matthew 16: 13-16). Time permitting, we will have a stop at Gideon Springs. Then we visit Magdala to see the recent excavations of a synagogue from the time of Jesus. Next, we will visit Beit Shean, one of the best-preserved Decapolis Roman cities. This is where King Saul and his sons’ bodies were hung from the city walls after being defeated by the Philistines (1 Samuel 31:10-12). We will then ascend to the majestic city of Jerusalem to join together for a special time with a local family for a Shabbat dinner. Then we transfer to our hotel in Jerusalem for overnight. “I was glad when they said to me, ‘Let us go to the house of the Lord.’ Our feet are standing within your gates, O Jerusalem” (Psalm 122: 1-2).

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DAY 6 – SATURDAY, MAY 12TH: MT. OF OLIVES, PALM SUNDAY ROAD, GARDEN OF GETHSEMANE, CHURCH OF THE HOLY SEPULCHRE, BETHLEHEM

We begin the day on the beautiful Mt. of Olives to behold the breathtaking panorama of the Holy City. Our pilgrimage proceeds down the Old Palm Sunday Road to the Garden of Gethsemane with its ancient olive grove, and the Church of the Agony, where tradition holds that Jesus prayed. We make our way to St. Stephen's Gate, to walk the Via Dolorosa – including St. Anne's Crusader Church, Pool of Bethesda, the Pavement (where Jesus stood while being tried by Pilate), Ecce Homo Arch, and the ancient Cardo. We continue to the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. We conclude our sightseeing with a visit to Bethlehem. We pass by Rachel's tomb on the outskirts, and visit the Church of the Nativity, Shepherd's Field, and the cave of Jerome. We will also have a visit to a local Baptist Church. Then we return to our hotel in Jerusalem for dinner and overnight.

DAY 7 – SUNDAY, MAY 13TH: TEMPLE MOUNT, RABBINICAL TUNNELS, JEWISH QUARTER, TEMPLE INSTITUTE, SOUTHERN STEPS, CITY OF DAVID, HEZEKIAH'S TUNNEL

This morning we will enter Jerusalem through the Zion Gate and walk to the holiest site in the whole Jewish world, the Western (Wailing) Wall of Herod's temple. Beyond the wall lies the 35-acre temple area purchased by King David (2 Samuel 24:18-25). On this site now stands El-Aksa Mosque, and the Dome of the Rock (the third holiest shrine in Islam). Conditions permitting, we will include a visit to the Temple Mount. Then we walk along the Rabbi's Tunnel and come as close as is possible to the Holy of Holies. We continue our tour of Jerusalem, the City of God, to the Jewish Quarter for a unique visit of the Temple Institute. Here, we will see some of the preparations being made for the Third Temple. Then we make our way to the Southern Steps, the archaeological reconstruction of the Temple Steps where Jesus walked so often. Next, we drive to the incredible archaeological find, the City of David. Here we take a short walk to Hezekiah's Tunnel (conditions permitting). Be sure to bring a flashlight and good water shoes with you, as you will get wet walking through the tunnel. (Those who prefer to stay dry can walk through the shaft). If time permits, we will briefly visit the new excavations of the Pool of Siloam. We return to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

DAY 8 – MONDAY, MAY 14TH: TEMPLE MOUNT SIFTING PROJECT AT EMEK ZURIM, (THE TEMPLE MOUNT SIFTING PROJECT), SHRINE OF THE BOOK, YAD VASHEM, GARDEN TOMB

After breakfast, we will join in a sifting project at Emek Zurim. Afterwards, we will visit the city outside the walls. We will pass by the Supreme Court House, the Knesset (Israeli Parliament) and the famous Rose Garden on the way to the Yad Vashem Museum. This is the memorial to the victims of the Holocaust. We will enjoy the world-renowned Israel Museum, recently renovated and enhanced. It includes the Second Temple Model and the Shrine of the Book where the Dead Sea Scrolls are housed. We conclude the tour with communion at Golgotha and the Garden Tomb and return to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

ITINERARY



DAY 9 – TUESDAY, MAY 15TH: QASR EL-YAHUD, QUMRAN, ENGEDI, MASADA, DEAD SEA

After breakfast, we depart from Jerusalem and drive to the Jordan River for an optional time of baptisms at the traditional site where Jesus was baptized by John the Baptist at Qasr el Yahud. Then we make our way to the Judean Wilderness. The road from Jerusalem to the Dead Sea region is a descent of 4,000 feet in 13 miles. Our first stop will be at Qumran, the settlement of the first century sect known as the Essenes, authors of the Dead Sea Scrolls. Afterwards, a short drive takes us to Engedi where David hid from King Saul and from here we will drive to Masada for lunch and then we will take a cable car to the fortress built by King Herod. Here we survey the ruins of fortifications, waterworks, synagogue, temples and palaces. Dinner and overnight will be at the Dead Sea.

DAY 10 – WEDNESDAY, MAY 16TH: LEISURE AT THE DEAD SEA, ELAH VALLEY, JAFFA, FAREWELL DINNER, BEN GURION AIRPORT

This morning we will have leisure time at the Dead Sea to enjoy floating in the water and the hotel spa (some services not included). Lunch is on your own at the resort (not included). In early afternoon, we depart the Dead Sea area and begin our sightseeing with a relaxing drive to the Elah Valley and the brook where David slew Goliath. From here, we continue to Jaffa for a special Farewell Dinner. We transfer to Ben Gurion airport for the flight back to the U.S.A.

DAY 11 – THURSDAY, MAY 17TH: THURSDAY: ARRIVE BACK IN U.S.A.

We arrive back to the U.S.A. at the close of an unforgettable tour. We take home wonderful memories of the Old and New Testaments, a renewal of our faith, and a greater understanding of the life of our Lord.

Enrollment in and payment of your deposit for the tour, constitutes your acceptance of the conditions and statement of responsibility.

INCLUDED IN PRICE: 1) Round trip airfare per brochure, deluxe motor coaches, First Class / Superior First Class hotels, guided sightseeing, entrance fees to sites visited, breakfast, 7 lunches, and dinners daily; 2) Taxes and fuel charges totaling \$701.42 USD comprised of \$371.02 for fuel charges (subject to increase by airline up to 30 days prior to departure) and \$330.40 for taxes (including federal inspection fees for the U.S. Customs and Immigrations; international air transportation tax; agricultural tax; other per person taxes imposed by government entities; airport taxes and fees including the September 11th Security fee up to \$10 per person, passenger facility charges up to \$18 per person, federal domestic flight segment fees up to \$3.50 per segment and U.S. and International arrival and departure, and other government imposed fees up to \$300 per person); 3) Gratuities of \$175 for tour guide or cruise director, local host, driver, local guides, and/or ships' crew; gratuities on ferries, and cruise ships.

NOT INCLUDED IN PRICE: Not included in your package are passports, visas, vaccinations, laundry, 1 lunch, telephone, mini-bar, alcohol, other beverages, and food outside of the contracted tour operator menu as presented at a hotel or restaurant (these extra items will be billed to you before leaving the hotel, or restaurant), airport transfers on non-qualifying flights, portage at airports, travel insurance, excess baggage fees, any fees or fuel surcharges imposed by the airlines after the date you register for your trip, and all other items not specifically mentioned.

PAYMENT: A full deposit of \$500 per person is required at time of registration. Final payment must be made in the form of a check (credit cards are only accepted for initial deposit, any remaining payments must be in check form) and is due no later than 90-days prior to departure. Registrations received after 90-days prior to departure must be accompanied by full payment. There may be a late fee of \$195 for all payments or new registrations received 75-60 days prior to departure. All tour prices are based on a minimum group size of 20 passengers for prices to be valid. If group size is 19-15 travelers, a \$150 per person supplement to price may apply. If group size is 14-10 travelers, a \$195 per person supplement to price may apply. If group size is less than 10 travelers, the tour may be cancelled due to lack of participation. If final (full) payment is not received by *imagine* Tours and Travel, LLC (hereafter referred to as *imagine*) 60-days prior to departure, you will be automatically cancelled from the tour and your initial deposit of \$500 will be forfeited. *imagine* reserves the right to add a surcharge if the dollar declines by more than 2% against the shekel or euro based on foreign exchange rates in effect on date when your tour was booked by your tour leader/church. All payments are required in US Funds.

ACCOMMODATIONS: Price is based on double occupancy (two persons sharing a room). When available, single rooms are often smaller than doubles. While *imagine* will try to match roommates, we cannot guarantee one will be available. Roommates may be assigned as late as 35 days prior to departure. If one is not available or if you request a single room, there will be a single room supplement charge: \$799 for basic itinerary.

ITINERARY and CHANGES: Because airlines often change flight schedules after brochures are printed, *imagine* reserves the right to shorten or lengthen the itinerary accordingly. You will be notified in writing when possible. If itinerary changes necessitate extra overnights, you will be charged \$195 per night/per person (single rooms \$225/night). Meals for extra nights are not included. Any changes and/or deviations from the program and/or departure city listed by the passenger must be provided in writing to *imagine* no later than 75-days prior to departure and any extra costs incurred will be billed to the passenger. All deviations are subject to a standard fee of \$150 plus any applicable airline fees. All tours are final at 60-days prior to departure. No changes and/or additions may be made to the tour after that time.

LAND ONLY: Land Only price is \$4092 per person. Price does not include international flights. Land Only passengers may be responsible for transfers and/or additional overnights incurred by booking their own flights. We recommend you purchase a ticket which can be changed without large penalties, as the group's flights may change. Passengers changing from the regular tour to Land Only after 120 days prior to departure will be charged a fee of \$150 per person.

AIRLINE TICKETS: In order to keep prices low, *imagine* does not guarantee you will be on the most direct flights to your final destination. *imagine* also does not guarantee the group will be on the same flights. Flight routings are chosen by the airlines and not *imagine*. Airline tickets cannot be changed or refunded once issued. Air transportation to/from your destination will be economy class aboard IATA and ARC carriers utilizing APEX or SUPER APEX non-refundable, non-amendable tickets for groups of 10 or more flying together for entire itinerary. *imagine* is unable to use individual frequent flyer points to upgrade or accept them as partial payment for air transportation. Deviations by the passenger, from the group's scheduled flights, could result in different routings/air carriers.

VISAS: Applicable visas will be obtained by *imagine* for U.S. and Canadian Citizens only. All passengers who do not carry U.S. or Canadian Passports will be responsible for obtaining visas to the countries they are visiting. *imagine* is not responsible for non-U.S. & Canadian Passport holders.

FLIGHT TIMES: All flight times are subject to change by the airlines without advance notice. *imagine* is not responsible for such changes or delays and does not reimburse expenses resulting from such delays. If making your own flight arrangements to a departure city or any other portion of your trip, we recommend you purchase a ticket which can be changed without large penalties. Passengers are responsible for reconfirming their flights with the airline 24 hours prior to departure.

CANCELLATION FEES: If the tour is cancelled due to lack of participation, there will be a charge of \$150 deducted from the amount refunded to each passenger for administrative fees plus any airline penalties if applicable. Any passenger cancelling from day of registration to 100 days prior to departure will be charged a \$300 non-refundable administrative fee per person plus any airline penalties, if applicable. You will also be charged a single room fee if your cancellation forces your roommate into a single room from 59 days prior until the date of departure. The following charges also apply: 99-60 days = \$500; 59-45 days = \$1750; 44-25 days = 75% of total cost; 24 days to day of departure = 100% of total cost. All Cancellations must be received in writing. On or after the day of departure there is no refund for any services not used. We strongly recommend you purchase travel insurance.
