Ecclesiastes 8:14-15

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

In what ways are we taught that we are just "brains on sticks?"

Colin mentions the presidential election and the debate over human sexuality as litmus tests for dividing people by what they think. What other litmus tests are used to divide us by what we think?

What does the author of Ecclesiastes mean when he says dividing "good" people and "bad" people is "pointless?"

Jesus says the most important commandment is to love God and neighbor (Matt. 22:35-40). What does Pastor Colin mean when he says you can't fulfill this commandment on your own?
