### **JESUS DESERVES OUR WORSHIP**

### **Just for Parents**

A few years back the speaker at our Men's Retreat, Grant Fishbook, shared with us that the first thing we should think about when we wake up in the morning should be God. This has stuck with me and caused me to evaluate my life more than once. Let's take this one step further. What if we greeted our kids in the morning with "Good morning, God's got a great day planned for you today!" or something like that. Maybe a little awkward at first but just think about talking with your family about God first thing in the morning. What a great way to worship Him.

#### Lesson

- Go over a definition of worship:
  - Worship is telling someone how super awesome they are, that you love them very much and that there is no one or anything else like them anywhere.
- Read Mark 14: 1-11 together as a family and discuss the following questions
  - o Why did the lady pour the perfume on Jesus' head? Vs. 6 7
  - o How much was the perfume worth? Vs. 5
  - Why was what this lady did more important than helping the poor? Vs. 7
    - The poor they would always be able to help but Jesus would not always be physically with them
    - This lady showed Jesus she loved Him and wanted to worship Him
    - The most important thing in our lives is to worship God

### Respond

- Review the above definition of worship and discuss how you can worship God as a family this week. Choose from one of the following options or come up with your own way to show Jesus how awesome He is.
  - o Do something special for someone else and tell them that Jesus loves them
  - Have a time of family prayer where each member has the opportunity to pray telling God how much they love Him and how awesome He is.
  - As a family write a letter to God telling Him how great you think He is
  - Give some money or food to one of the "food banks" in our community
    - Southeast Helping Hands, Soups On or Community Outreach


### Blessing


