Hint: Mary shows us the type of *urgency* that Paul is talking about. Do you think many Christians view the pursuit of unity within the church with that same urgency? *Why or why not?*
- 4. **Ephesians 4:14-16** talks extensively about the benefits of a united church. Ask a volunteer to read **Ecclesiastes 4:9-12**. Between those two passages, what do you see as the top benefits from living in close community with other disciples of Jesus?
- 5. The theme passage for our renewed emphasis on Life Groups is **1 Thessalonians 2:8**. Read the larger context of that passage—**1 Thessalonians 2:7-12**—and work together as a
