

SARAH WAS A THREE-SPORT STAR AT ONE OF THE BEST COLLEGES IN THE COUNTRY. NOT ONLY THAT, SHE WAS THE SOPHOMORE CAPTAIN OF ALL THREE TEAMS, AND SHE HAD JUST BEEN NAMED CO-WINNER OF THE COLLEGE'S BEST FEMALE ATHLETE AWARD.

WITH SUCH ABILITY AND RECOGNITION, YOU WOULD THINK THAT SHE WAS FEELING PRETTY GOOD ABOUT HERSELF, BUT SHE WAS ALREADY WORRIED ABOUT NEXT YEAR. THE EXPECTATIONS OF OTHERS WERE GOING TO BE EVEN GREATER.

HOW COULD SHE TOP WHAT SHE HAD ALREADY ACCOMPLISHED? "SHE SAID SHE WANTED TO BE THE BEST GIRLFRIEND, THE BEST ATHLETE, THE BEST STUDENT," RELATED A GOOD FRIEND. SHE WANTED TO QUIT ONE OF HER SPORTS TO ALLEVIATE SOME OF THE OVERWHELMING STRESS IN HER LIFE,

BUT SHE WAS AFRAID TO DISAPPOINT HER TEAMMATES. SAYING "NO" TO ANY FRIEND WAS OUT OF THE QUESTION. "SHE WANTED TO PLEASE EVERYBODY AND COULDN'T STOP," ONE PERSON OBSERVED. SHE COULD ONLY THINK OF ONE WAY OUT.

SARAH TOOK A .22-CALIBER RIFLE AND SHOT HERSELF IN THE CHEST. PEOPLE HAD BECOME SARAH'S IDOL. SHE NEEDED THEIR APPROVAL. SHE NEEDED THEIR FRIENDSHIP, AND SHE FELT UTTERLY SUFFOCATED BY THE POSSIBILITY OF DISAPPOINTING THEM.

THE TRAGIC REALITY WAS THAT SARAH WAS A SLAVE TO HER IDOL OF PEOPLE-PLEASING, AND TRAGEDY OFTEN ACCOMPANIES SUCH SLAVERY. SARAH SAW NO OTHER WAY TO FREEDOM.


PEOPLE-PLEASERS

THE WILLINGNESS TO PRIORITIZE THE FEELINGS AND EXPECTATIONS OF OTHERS BECAUSE OF THE THREAT OF:

- 1. PHYSICAL HARM AND OPPRESSION,
- 2. EXPOSURE AND HUMILIATION, OR
- 3. REJECTION AND RIDICULE.

17 Thus the sin of the young men was very great in the sight of the Lord, for the men treated the offering of the Lord with contempt.

THE **FAT** WAS THOUGHT TO BE THE MOST LUXURIOUS, BEST PART OF THE ANIMAL, SO THEY GAVE IT TO GOD. THE IDEA WAS THAT GOD SHOULD ALWAYS GET THE BEST, AND GOD SHOULD GET HIS PORTION FIRST.

BUT IN THEIR PRIDE, THE SONS OF ELI TOOK THEIR PORTION BEFORE THEY BURNED THE FAT. THE GREED OF ELI'S SONS WAS SO BAD THAT THEY DID NOT HESITATE TO USE VIOLENCE AND THE THREAT OF VIOLENCE TO GET WHAT THEY WANTED.
