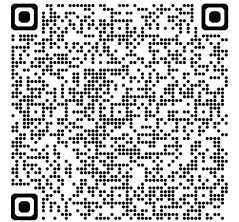
## New Sunday School Class – Next Week May 31<sup>st</sup>
