Willingness to Die to Self | Seen in Paul's titles (vs. 1-2)

Paul = Small/Humble

Pauls calling = Gospel to Gentiles (Acts 9:15)

- -Dying to ourselves involves a willingness to put aside personal privilege.
- -Dying to self involves a willingness to deny merit. (v.2)
- -In God's economy we are always in every dimension of life a recipient of unconditional grace, and never deserving of any of it.

- -The Gentiles would not like this bc it would require entry into the covenant of the Jews



In thinking along those lines about a costliness to our call--"God's whisper tends to be equal parts enlivening and terrifying resonating deeply with our souls while also coming at a cost requiring a great amount of risk—and we never graduate from this. You will never reach a stage of spiritual maturity in your life where God's voice is not equally terrifying and enlivening. You will never reach a place where it is all fruit and no cost. You will never reach a place where it is all faith and no risk. We never graduate...the second your spirituality becomes comfortable I would start to question if it's God that you're still listening to. Living by God's voice is not a method—it is a radical commitment to terrifying obedience, and it is a stubborn resilience to risk your own foolishness."
