



IMMEASURABLY money

Context: Thus far Jesus has...

- proclaimed the gospel of God (1:14)
- · invested in disciping Peter, Andrew, James & John 1:17-20)
- publicly taught in the synagogue (1:21)
- publicly cast out a demon in the synagogue (1:25)
- healed Peter's MIL (1:30)
- physically healed & cast out demons of many in Capernaum (1:34)
- continued preaching & casting out demons all throughout Galilee (1:39)
- healed a man of leprosy (1:41)

Jesus' ministry wasn't one of him existing at a distance in obscurity. He was actively involved in the mess of peoples lives.

Israel's version of Messiah: A militarized zealot who would save them from the oppression of men.

God's plan of a Messiah: A suffering servant who would save them from the oppression of sin.
