
2 Identities in which God views all Humanity:

"In Adam" -Born into this -Leads to death

21 For as by a man [Adam] came death, by a man [Jesus] has come also the resurrection of the dead. 22 For as in Adam all die, so also in Christ shall all be made alive. -1 Cor. 15:21-22

-Throughout the NT Paul writes about our identity being "in Christ" or "in Him" 216 times

"In Christ" -Reborn into this -Leads to life





3 Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us in Christ with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places, 4 even as he chose) Goal of Election: Conformity to Christ (Rmns. 8:28-29) us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and Purpose of Election: Adoption into the Family blameless before him. In love 5 he predestined us for adoption to himself as sons through Jesus Christ, according to the purpose of his will, 6 to the praise of his glorious grace, with which he has blessed us in the Beloved.

-Other places election is tied to salvation: Rom. 9-11; Acts 13:48; Tit. 1:1; 1 Pet. 1:1; 2 Pet. 1:10 -Eph 1:13 clearly shows us the necessity of personal belief in the gospel -"Salvation belongs to the Lord" -Jonah 2:9

"Election is the gracious purpose of God, according to which He regenerates, justifies, sanctifies, and glorifies sinners. It is consistent with the free agency of man, and comprehends all the means in connection with the end. It is the glorious display of God's sovereign goodness, and is infinitely wise, holy, and unchangeable. It excludes boasting and promotes humility."







"As God hath appointed the elect unto glory, so hath He, by the eternal and most free purpose of His will, foreordained all the means thereunto. Wherefore they who are elected being fallen in Adam are redeemed by Christ, are effectually called unto faith in Christ by His Spirit working in due season; are justified, adopted, sanctified, and kept by His power through faith unto salvation. Neither are any other redeemed by Christ, effectually called, justified, adopted, sanctified, and saved, but the elect only."
