- 2016 Lifeway Research did a survey in geared around engagement with the Scriptures:
- ·Only 20% of Americans say they've read the entire Bible at least once.
- Only 22% percent say they systematically read through a section of the Bible a little each day.
- ·47% say the Bible is 100 percent accurate in all it teaches.
- ·51% say the Bible was written for each person to interpret as he or she chooses.
- ·74% disagree with the idea that even the smallest sin deserves eternal damnation.
- ·77% say people must contribute their own effort for personal salvation.
- •52% say good deeds help them earn a spot in heaven. And 45% believe there are many ways to get there.

2022 Ligonier Ministries State of Theology Report:

Among US Adults:

•The Bible, like all sacred writings, contains helpful accounts of ancient myths but is not literally true.

53% agreed

Among US Evangelicals:

- •God accepts the worship of all religions, including Christianity, Judaism, and Islam. 56% agree
- •Jesus was a great teacher, but he was not God. 43% agree
