4 Gifts of Ephesians 4

- 1. Apostle: These were appointed by Christ as his witnesses & empowered by his Spirit to write the NT together.
- 2. Prophet: original 1st century prophets who taught & preserved the faith in association w/ the apostles until the NT was completed (Don't think Paul is referring to the prophecy gift of all Christians in evangelism & biblical insight because of Eph. 2:20)
- 3. Evangelist: These are those who are gifted in making the gospel plain & relevant to the lost or helping fearful people share their faith. The unique gifting to take complex theology & make it plain for all to hear.
- 4. Pastor/Teacher: Pastor literally means shepherd. Those who have been appointed to know, lead, feed, guide, & protect Christ's church.
